PDAP: Our abstinence-based program offering guidance through counseling and peer-to-peer support groups for youth, siblings and parents. We focus on **family** recovery.

YRCC: Our youth-driven recovery program provides a safe space for young people (13-21) to share their creative recovery journeys with youth recovery coaches and receive support for reaching goals in their daily lives.

YOUTH LEADERSHIP: Giving back is part of recovery. Our leadership development camps, retreats, and other special events offer young people in active recovery a place to find their leadership voice in our community.

EDUCATION & PREVENTION: Peers and loved ones of those engaging in substance abuse are placed at higher risk of making devastating choices in their own lives. We offer special support in schools and in our community centers to reach near-risk youth when a substance abuse problem is identified in their home or school environment.
